Bryna Kra is the Sarah Rebecca Roland Professor of Mathematics at Northwestern University. She was awarded the Centennial Fellowship of the American Mathematical Society in 2006 and the Conant Prize of the American Mathematical Society in 2010. In 2016, she became a fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences and in 2019 she was elected to the National Academy of Sciences. She has held positions at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem in Israel, the Institute des Hautes Etudes Scientifiques in France, at the University of Michigan, the Ohio State University, and Pennsylvania State University, before joining the faculty at Northwestern University in 2004. In 2016 she was elected to the Board of Trustees of the American Mathematical Society and is currently serving as chair of the board.
